Brief Profile of Shri Rajeeva, Executive Director of Punjab & Sind Bank

Shri Rajeeva has assumed charge as Executive Director of the Bank today. Prior to his elevation as Executive Director of Punjab & Sind Bank, he was Chief General Manager of Punjab National Bank. Shri Rajeeva, a postgraduate in Arts, is also a Master of Business Administration in Banking & Finance and a Certified Associate of Indian Institute of Bankers (CAIIB).

He joined the services of Punjab National Bank in 1993.
